WHAT DOES A VOLUNTEERING DAY INVOLVE?

No two volunteering days are the same and our Volunteer Coordinator will provide you with a specific itinerary for your team. A sample day:

- 10 am: arrive, sign in, overview of the project to be undertaken, health and safety briefing.
- 10.20am: let the fun begin!
- · 12.30-1pm lunch.
- · 1pm back to work.

• 3.30pm-4pm finishing up and clearing away tools. Throughout the day there will be refreshments available, tea, coffee, juice.

How much does a corporate day cost?

Depending on the activity, prices start from £600 for small corporate groups of 8, please contact for more information.

Why is there a cost involved?

As a charity the cost of delivering a meaningful, enjoyable day and safe activity for your team are covered. We need to include the cost of materials, staff costs and hiring of equipment if need be.

What should I wear?

We will provide you with guidance nearer the time depending on the activity you are doing. Protective and safety equipment will be provided the day if necessary. For outdoor work, weather appropriate clothing is needed.
